Dear Parents,

In 1992, the Pennfield Board of Education adopted a K-12 Health and Reproductive Education Program. This program was recommended after two years of study and work by an advisory committee consisting of parents, students, teachers, clergy, health professional, and administrators. Before making the curriculum recommendation to the Board of Education, the P.A. 226 Community Advisory Committee did a survey of the parents and students, reviewed state requirements, studied the research, and consulted with the community, parents, and health officials.

Health and reproductive education is offered at Dunlap Elementary to the fourth and fifth grade students. The teachers who provide instruction are trained and certified to teach the program. In compliance with Public Act 336 of 1993, you have the right to examine the materials that are being used in this program. The attached scope and sequence outlines your child's course study for kindergarten through twelfth grade. Please contact the building principal at 961-9789, if you wish to review the instructional materials.

Your child is scheduled to participate in this program of instruction. By law, you have the right to visit during instruction or have your child excused without penalty. Other appropriate educational activities will be provided. A written notice, signed and dated, will be necessary to make this request. Please direct your notification to Dirk VanDiver, Principal.
