Technology Work Days - This was one of the most requested PDs. Use these days to come in and work on the technology projects that you want to implement in your classroom. Moodle Mania -Expand your classroom with Moodle. Use this tool to create classes where you can post assignments, weblinks, text, images, documents, announcements and many other items.. Moodle is a program comparable to Blackboard, eChalk or WebCT. This can be used at any grade level. This is a beginner course. Walk out with a class that is ready to use. (MDL section 11)

Wednesday August 19, 8:00- 12:00

Moodle Mania—the adventure continues— Already have a Moodle class and want to take it to the next level? This class is for you. We will look at some of the advanced features of Moodle and how to add interaction to your site. Create guided activities using many different tools. Also learn how to bring some of the new web2.0 sites into your class as well. (MDL 600 section 5)

Wednesday, August 20, 8-11

PK-2 Tech Integration—Are you asking yourself “Does any of this stuff work for me? This class will look at tools you can use to integrate technology into your curriculum. We will focus on the specific needs of PK—2nd grade teachers. (Integ 594 section 2)

3-5 Technology Integration—We will take a look at the resources and tools available to you to integrate technology into your classroom. We will focus on the specific needs of 3rd—5th grade teachers. (Integ 596 section 1)

Middle School Moodle Academy—When you walk out, you will have a moodle class ready to use for this school year. We will look at the different resources and activities that can be used in Moodle to extend the tools available in your classroom and at home. (MDL section 12)

Wikis—We will look at how Wikispaces can be used in your classroom as a collaborative tool for students. Students can post their work, peer edit information, gather information for projects and much more. Wikispaces is easy to use and it is free. (Integ 586 section 1)

The many ways to communicate—There are so many technologies out there that can help you communicate and be in contact with parents, students and staff. We will look at some of these ways that are available for free! You will be amazed at what is available and what it can do. (Tech 561 section 1)

Tuesday August 11 8:00-11:00

How do I manage it all? This session will look at how to manage a classroom where technology is being used. Whether it is the laptop program, using an open lab or rolling in a COW, this should help you to keep students on track and engaged in the activity. We will look at Lanschool along with techniques that help to make your classroom sane. (Integ 568 section 1)
